



Betty Rogers Zylewitz

June 16, 1922 - February 25, 2012

Mrs. Zylewitz, 89, died Feb. 25 from complications from a fall. She was born June 16, 1922, in Richmond, Va., the only child of Wesley and Bernie Rogers.
