Charles "Chuck" Allen Logan was born on July 23, 1938 in Prineville, OR, the son of Fisher and Evelyn (Snyder) Logan. He was a fourth generation Oregonian. The family moved to Beaverton, OR when Chuck was 3 where he attended local schools and graduated from Beaverton High School in 1956.

His education continued with a Bachelor's degree in 1960 and a Master's degree in 1964, both from Portland State University, and a Ph. D. from Oregon State University in 1979.

He taught in Alsea, OR from 1960 to 1964 and then moved to Redmond, OR where he taught at Redmond High School from 1964 to 1990. He mainly taught US History and was instrumental in starting the US History Advanced Placement program during those years. In 1971-72 he coached Redmond High School's 3 time winner of KGW television's High-Q program, an Oregon high school quiz show. Chuck was very active in union activities for many years and was involved with contract negotiations in Redmond and other area

schools.

In 1968 he married Marcia Watkins and they celebrated their 54th wedding anniversary in June.

Throughout his life he has had many hobbies and interests including woodworking, gardening, reading, art, traveling, acquiring many interesting collections and caring for his much-loved cats. He and Marcia traveled extensively overseas, taking notes and photographs that he used in his classes to bring the outside world to his Redmond High School students. For many years he was very active in his local homeowner's association.

Chuck had 3 children: Allen and John (wife Nancy) who survive and Susan who died in 1998. He has 4 grandchildren: Jessica Crowell and husband Trevor, Douglas Logan and wife Angela, Samuel Logan and Susan Logan. He also has three step grandchildren: David, Terry, and Chelsea. Other survivors include his sister Laurel Wantz and her 6 children, Cyndi, Wendy, Laurie, Bill, Bob and James, and cousin Sally Shook (husband Will).

Chuck and Marcia established the Charles & Marcia Logan Scholarship through the Oregon Community Foundation in 2014 and since then have awarded \$73,000 in college scholarships to Redmond High School graduates.
