Floyd Daniel Hauff passed away peacefully in his home October 11, 2013 at age 82. Born on December 9, 1930 in McIntosh County, North Dakota and raised on the family farm, he had a deep love for the land that lasted through a long career with the U.S.D.A., Soil Conservation Service.
