James Lee (Jim) Reynolds of Redmond, Oregon, died peacefully May 12, 2015 from complications due to Progressive Supranuclear Palsy (PSP). His passing was mercifully swift and he was surrounded by his loved ones. He was 72. A Funeral Mass will take place Wednesday, May 20, 2015, at 2:00 PM at St. Thomas Catholic Church, located at 720 NW 19th St., Redmond, Oregon. Jim was born May 3, 1943 in Memphis, Tennessee. On May 21, 1974, he married Diane Simone Bourassa. Jim retired in 1999 after working as a teacher, coach and principal for over 30 years. Much of that time was spent in the bush of Alaska along the Kuskokwim River. He lived most of his life in Oregon, Washington and Alaska. Jim loved football and will be remembered for his knowledge of past games, coaches and spectacular plays. In his retirement, he enjoyed riding his Harley-Davidson motorcycle, metal detecting, and "surfing the net".
