Jonathan Glen "Jon" Winter, age 52, of Redmond, Oregon, passed away on September 18, 2022, from a heart attack while on vacation in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico.

Jon was born May 29, 1970, to Charles "Chuck" and Marilyn "Janette" (Davison) Winter in Tucson, Arizona. Early on, his family moved to Tulare, California, where Jon grew up in the company of his siblings and large extended family. He attended Tulare Schools and graduated in 1988 from Tulare Union High School. Jon suffered a tremendous loss at just 23 when he lost his mother and both grandmothers while he was fighting his own battle with testicular cancer. He overcame cancer and in 2004, Jon married his sweetheart, Kelly Stahl, and became a wonderful and loving second "Dad" to her two children, Kyle and Kyra. Born to their marriage was a daughter, Rhiannon "Annie" Janette, who was the apple of Jon's eye. Jon had been told that he might not ever be able to have a child and when Annie was born, Jon was the proudest father anyone has ever seen. Jon was a licensed painting contractor and was the fourth generation to carry on the legacy of the family

business, Winter Painting Service. He was a hard worker and took pride in a job well done.

Jon's greatest strength was his love of family and friends. He was an affectionate and doting husband, father, brother, and friend. He loved the outdoors, was an avid fisherman, loved hiking, Central Oregon microbrews, the Oregon Ducks, and enjoyed spending time with those he so deeply loved.

Jon was preceded in death by his parents, Charles and Janette (Davison) Winter. He is survived by his wife, Kelly (Stahl) Winter, son Kyle Ewing of Visalia, California, daughters Kyra Winter of Plano, Texas, and Rhiannon Winter of Redmond, Oregon, brothers Steven Winter (Erica) of Morro Bay, California, Samuel Winter (Marianne) of Visalia, California, sisters Sarah Winter (Clint) of Grants Pass, Oregon, and Rachel Winter Fannin (Travis) of West Jordan, Utah, his grandfather, Glen Winter, of Meeker, Oklahoma, his step-mother, Katy Barnes Winter, of Saratoga Springs, Utah, his loving mom-in-law, Sharan "Sherry" Huff Stahl, of the home, numerous aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
