



Richard "Dick" Eades

On Thursday, September 26, 2019, Richard "Dick" Eades, long-time resident of Central Oregon, passed away peacefully at his home in Prineville, Oregon, surrounded by his family. Dick was born on October 29, 1939 in Utah to Orville and Bernice Eades. In 1963 he married Mary Imajean Jones, from London, Kentucky. They met in Redmond at the 86 Corral Restaurant where Jean was working.

Early in his career, Dick worked for the Corrections Department in Salem, and later transferred to State Corrections Facility. In 1969, Dick and Jean moved to Madras, where they owned and ran the Top Notch Restaurant for 5 years. During that time, Dick went to work for the City of Madras road department and retired from there. In 2002, Dick and Jean moved to Prineville.

He spent 6 years serving our country as a Marine. He was stationed in San Diego with the US Marine Corps Platoon 380, and after his commission was over he joined the Marine Corps Reserves. Dick was a longstanding member of the Order of Elks. As a teenager he was in The DeMolay (Masons).

His passion and favorite hobbies were fishing and motorcycles. Dick enjoyed taking long rides on his Harley Davidson motorcycle with his friends. He also enjoyed long weekends at Pine Hollow and Walton Lake, taking his grandchildren fishing. Dick was an outdoor enthusiast, and enjoyed taking his

boat out on the lake. He was known as a kind and caring person, always willing to listen and lend a helping hand.

Dick was preceded in death by his parents, two infant daughters (Karen and Rebecca) and son Nick Eades. He is survived by his loving wife, Jean, son Mark Eades, daughter Sandra (Matt) Spiker, 8 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.

A viewing will be held at the Redmond Memorial Chapel on October 5th at 9 am, followed by a graveside service at 11 am the Redmond Cemetery in Redmond, Oregon. Loren Jenson, nephew, will be officiating at the service. A Celebration of Life luncheon will be back at the Chapel at noon.
