



Richard Lee "Dick" Neises

Richard was predeceased by his parents, Raymond and Frances (Mitte) Neises, and twin sisters, Anita Timmerman (Tim), and Juanita (infancy). He is survived by wife, Beverly, daughter Amy, son Daniel (Julia), and one grandson; brothers Lawrence "Lars" Neises (Rebecca), James "Jim" Neises (Mary), sister Lois Cowan (Jerry), and numerous nieces and nephews.

Richard graduated from Ramona High School, California, and San Bernardino Valley College while serving as a fireman for the Muscoy Fire Department during the Watts Riots. He served in the US Navy during the Vietnam War, stationed aboard the USS Frank Knox, later serving in the US Naval Reserves. Richard and Beverly married in 1970 and moved to Oregon in 1972. He worked first for Southern California Edison, and then 34 years for Portland General Electric as a control operator at the Trojan Nuclear Power Plant and Beaver Generating Station. They moved to Redmond Oregon in 2009.

Richard was a dedicated Christian who faithfully supported his church, Central Baptist of Bend, Oregon. He used his arsenal of MacGyver-like skills for wood carving and building and restoring classic cars and hot rods. His generosity, wild sense of adventure, and well-honed goofy sense of humor will be dearly

missed.
