



## Robert William Fisher

November 10, 1937 - June 23, 2012

Bob was born November 10, 1937 to William H. and Eunice R. (Rathbun) Fisher in Alhambra, California. He was the oldest son and second of five children. His parents preceded him in death. Bob was a baseball standout in high school and college, having played first base for the Citrus College Owls. He is a member of the Citrus College Baseball Hall of Fame. He was a veteran of the California Air National Guard and United States Air Force, in which he served as an aircraft mechanic ground crew member. Bob married Francine Kay Phillips on September 16, 1961 in Fullerton, California. The couple moved to Mehama, Oregon, where they purchased a home and property along the north fork of the North Santiam River. Over the years, they raised racing quarter horses and operated small ranches in Salem, Creswell and Bend. The couple last lived in Roseburg before moving to Redmond in 2011, where Bob retired after working more than 50 years in the petroleum industry. On September 16, 2011 the couple celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in the company of family and close friends. Bob enjoyed studying military history, collecting firearms, and riding his Harley Davidson motorcycle. He is survived by his wife of nearly 51 years, Francine; four children: Karalea, Brett, Matthew and Marc; daughters-in-law Lisa and Jenilee; granddaughter Emma; sisters Elizabeth and Mary; brothers George and Charles; brother-in-law Ralph Phillips; sisters-in-law LeeAnne and Denise, and nephew Jonathan Fisher. A funeral will be held Friday, June 29 at Calvary Chapel Bend, 20225 Cooley Road off Highway 20 West in Bend at 10:30 a.m., followed by a private
