



## Sarah (Dottie) Evelyn Platt

Sarah Evelyn Platt (Dottie) was born on September 11, 1923, in Agate Colorado, died December 21, 2022, Redmond, Oregon. She was 99 years 3 months old at time of her passing.

She married Eugene Edward Platt 1944 in Longmont Colorado, where she worked for Bell Telephone, moved to Eugene Oregon in 1956 where they owned and operated a dairy farm. Dottie also worked for Oregon State University as a cook during this time.

Her and Gene moved to Alfalfa Or. in 1968 where they owned and operated a cattle & hay production ranch. They were members of the Oregon Cattlemen's association (Cowbells) and Hampton Grazing association. She missed her milk cows and as a source of income would hand milk several cows morning and night to sell bottled milk and cream to the Alfalfa Community. They retired in 1977 selling the cattle & hay ranches and building a new home for Sarah on forty acres in Alfalfa. She went to work for the Redmond School district as a cook at Alfalfa and later at Redmond High School.

She moved to a new home in Redmond in 1990, eventually living at Brookdale

Retirement until her death.

Surviving family include sons Ron, Gilbert (Suzi), Brian (Chris), Winton, Phil (Annie), and Frank (Monica), Fourteen grandchildren, Twenty-Seven great grandchildren, and One Great Great granddaughter.

She was preceded in death by husband Eugene, and grandson Steven Lee Platt.

Dottie loved to dance, sew, making teddy bears, had the green thumb of the family growing huge gardens and rose beds. Stayed active volunteering countless hours at the Redmond hospital, and Airlife. She loved her family and would keep everyone connected by having holiday parties with competitions for costumes, Easter egg hunts, the Greatest Pumpkin grown. She would always insist to feed anyone that stopped by to visit, loved people, was one of the kindest most caring mother and grandmother.
